NWFC PROGRAMS (Competitive + Adult 2 with lessons + Youth 2 with lessons)
MEMORANDUM UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

These three programs are the centerpiece of our efforts to produce elite competitive fencers for the local/national/international world stage. The center and our coaching staff devote significant time and costs to train and support this group of fencers. At the request of our Managing Head Coach and with support of the Executive Board of Directors, we need to create/clarify existing practices and policy for this year long program. This MOU is designed to ensure that all fencers/parents/coaches/staff have clarity.

1. To be a participant in these programs, a requirement by the fencer/parent will be to pay the monthly fee for the entire fencing season.
2. Fencing season is defined from September 1 through August 31 of the following year. If a fencer starts after September 1, the time frame will start from the 1st of the month enrolled to August 31.
3. To receive the benefits of these programs (discounted private lessons & camp discounts) a person must be enrolled and paid for the specific month the discounts are given.
4. Medical Exceptions: If a fencer is injured and out for a minimum of 60 days, they can request a waiver of monthly payment. This would require formal written directive by a qualified medical person stating the injury and that the recuperation process would be at least 60 days.
5. If a Medical waiver is allowed, during the period in which no monthly payment is made, no Competitive Program discounts for lessons or camps will be given.
6. Medical Exceptions will require documentation and approval by the Executive Director.
7. Returning to these programs from a medical waiver, would require monthly payment of the program fee in order to return to the program and receive lesson and camp discounts.
