2020 NWFC Financial Aid Program

NWFC's core principals:

- Access. Applying is easy.
- Fairness. Decisions are based on facts not feelings.
- Confidentiality. Applications are confidential.

Here is the procedure for applying:

- 1) Fill out the application form and send it to financialaid@nwfencing.org. This email is only accessible by the accountants at Plus And Minus, LLC.
- 2) The accountants will contact you with an invitation to submit the tax documentation through VeriFyle for security and confidentiality. If applicable, check the box "My financial situation substantially changed since 2019 taxes due to Covid-19."
- 3) Your application will be reviewed and compared to the chart below. You may receive up to a 50% discount on your class and lesson fees.
- 4) The accountants will notify you.

Benefits begin for applicants that are at or below 600% of the 2020 national poverty guidelines. The cut off amounts for qualifying annual income levels are:

Household of 1 = \$76,560	Household of 5 = \$184,080
Household of 2 = \$103,440	Household of 6 = \$210,960
Household of 3 = \$130,020	Household of 7 = \$237,840
Household of 4 = \$157,200	

The fine print.

Any financial aid awarded is for the current fencing season. We have a certain budget amount allocated, once it is reached the program will close for the season. The financial aid discount is applied only to classes and lessons, not to membership fees.
